Flu-vaccine: Please send in the proof of vaccine (dr. print-out, or physician script) as soon as your child has this done. It is required for all children ages 6 months up to 59 months. Any child within these ages without the flu vaccine, would be excluded, by state mandate, from our program from January 1-March 31st. Often December dates are scarce for appointments, so please don't wait. We will not accept children back after the holiday break without showing proof in our records. Thank you.
